Christmas Stocking Ornament

Chocolate Dog Studio

Intermediate Level

Notes

This pattern is written in U.S. crochet terminology. There is no gauge with this pattern as it is an ornament. You may use any weight yarn, as long

as it is a consistent weight. I used worsted weight yarn and the ornament is 3 ½ inches wide at the foot by 4 ¾ inches tall.



Supplies

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- Yarn: green, red and white
- Size G crochet hook
- Scissors

Skills

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- Single crochet
- Double crochet
- Magic circle
- Weave in ends
- Change colors
- Chain
- Slip stitch

Instructions

Granny Square

Using the red yarn, create a magic ring.

1st Round

Chain 1, (double crochet twice into the magic ring, chain 2), repeat 3 times. You will have 4 sets of 2 double crochet groups.

Slip stich to join, tie off, cut yarn, and weave in ends.

2nd Round

Using white yarn join to any chain 2 space (corner). In the corner (single crochet 2 times, chain 2, single crochet 2 times, single crochet between the next two dc), repeat 3 more times.

Slip stitch to join, tie off, cut yarn, and weave in ends.

Create 8 Granny Squares before moving on.



Using the dark green yarn, hold 2 squares together and single crochet along 1 edge to join. Connect 4 squares to make an L shape as shown in the photos.

Create 2 L's.

Holding the L's together, attach green yarn at top corner. Leaving the top unstitched, single crochet around the outside to join the L's.



If you used wool yarn for your ornament, you may wish to block it to get better shaping. Dampen the ornament with water and roll in towel to partially dry it. Pin ornament into shape (see photo) and allow to dry. It may take several days to dry. Be sure to use rust-proof pins to block.
